# Cummins Inc. to expand near Opryland

**Cummins Inc.** is expected to announce an expansion in Nashville tomorrow at Two Rivers Corporate Centre, just north of Opryland.

According to a city news release, Mayor Karl Dean and **Nashville Area Chamber of Commerce** CEO Ralph Schulz will make “an important economic development announcement tomorrow regarding the creation of new jobs in Nashville” at Two Rivers.

Not mentioned in the press release, but included in an invitation sent by the Chamber’s Partnership 2010 program, is that an official from Cummins Inc. will be joining them as well.

Cummins Inc.’s Cummins Filtration already has a Nashville presence on Elm Hill Pike.

Floyd Schechter, of building owner **SmartSpace**, declined comment ahead of Thursday’s announcement.

SmartSpace purchased the 284,000-square-foot property, a former outlet mall, in 2001.
